BOARD OF ELECTIONS & REGISTRATION
BOARD MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 9, 2026, 7:00 P.M.
BEALL CENTER**

- A. Petra Joyner called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Wayne Coachman gave the Invocation. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- B. A quorum was set with all Board members present. Those present were Petra Joyner, Wayne Coachman, Tracy Horne, Shandora Hopkins, Susan Moseley and Mike Rogerson, chief clerk of elections.
- C. Minutes from the February 9, 2026, Board meeting were read, and a motion to approve the minutes was made by Wayne Coachman and seconded by Tracy Horne. The vote to approve the minutes as read passed unanimously.
- D. New and Unfinished Business:
 - Mike Rogerson gave an update on plans that he and Ron Foskey have to reach out to local churches, the High School, and civic organizations to recruit poll workers. There is also a “poster” on the Board of Elections and Registration website.
 - Mike shared a letter from “The Center of Vulnerable Voters” with the Board - this organization offers assistance for election offices that want to help residents in personal care homes, assisted living facilities, and nursing homes with voter registration and election voting. Shandora shared that the social worker in the facility she works in helps their residents with voting. The Board suggested that Mike get in touch with our local administrators to see if they might be interested in this assistance.
 - Carol Heard (Liberty Votes) provided instruction and materials to clean the scanners at the Election meeting in Sylvester. Mike ordered the cleaning materials and he will also update us on the date he will be conducting Logistics and Accuracy (L&A) for the May election.
 - Mike shared information from a conversation he had with a member of the Seminole County Republican Party regarding qualifying local candidates - and he and Ron will draft a letter to the Chair specifying the Party’s responsibility in qualifying local candidates if they choose to do this independently from qualifying at the Board of Elections office.

Our next meeting will be April 13, 2026.

A motion to adjourn was made by Susan Moseley and seconded by Wayne Coachman.
